**ST. JUNIPERO SERRA (1713-84)**

St. Junipero Serra was a Spanish Franciscan priest and founder of the California missions. He established the first mission in present day California at San Diego in 1769, and went on to establish eight more missions, serving as president of the missions until his death. He was canonized by Pope Francis in 2015 and is considered the patron saint of California. His motto was "Always forward, never back." His feast is July 1<sup>st</sup>.
