ST. CECILIA

St. Cecilia was a second or third century martyr who died in Rome during a time of religious persecution. As a young girl, Cecilia fasted, prayed and pledged her life to God. However, her father arranged a marriage to the patrician Valerian. On their wedding night Cecilia informed Valerian about her pledge, and he allowed Cecilia to remain a virgin. She opened her house for prayer and spiritual direction, and hundreds were converted through her influence. Cecilia is honored as patron saint of music because of the song for God in her heart. Her feast day is November 22.
