**ST. FRANCES XAVIER CABRINI**

1850-1917 She is the patron saint of immigrants and the first U.S. citizen to be canonized. Born in Lombardy Italy, Maria Francesca Cabrini desired to be a sister but was refused entrance into two religious communities due to her delicate health. In 1880, Bishop Domenico Galmini encouraged her to establish a new congregation. The Institute of the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart won papal approval and grew rapidly. In 1889, Archbishop Michael Corrigan of New York invited Mother Cabrini and five of her sisters to his diocese, but when they arrived Corrigan rescinded his invitation and suggested that they return to Italy. The sisters remained and Cabrini established numerous hospitals, schools, orphanages and convents throughout the United States, as well as foundations in Central and South America. Mother Cabrini was canonized in 1946. Her feast day is November 13.
