**KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS**

On 14 April 1917, soon after the United States entered World War I, the board of directors for the Knights passed a resolution calling "for the active cooperation and patriotic zeal" of its members as part of the US war effort. The Order subsequently instituted a per capita tax on the membership to raise \$1 million (today \$22.4 MILLION) to provide for the welfare of troops fighting in Europe. Local councils also undertook their own fundraising drives which resulted in an additional \$14 (\$314.4) million. Canadian knights took up the cause even earlier, reflecting their closer links to Britain. 607-267-8336
