## ST. BRIDGET OF SWEDEN

1302-73, St. Bridget was a mystic from a noble family and a major religious figure of the late Middle Ages. As a widow with eight children, she founded the Brigittines, an order of women and men who lived in double monasteries with the abbess as superior. Like Catherine of Siena, Bridget worked for the return of the popes at Avignon to Rome. Her *Revelations*, in which there is a renewed interest, record her visions, spiritual experiences, and life. Her daughter was St. Katherine of Sweden. She died in Rome and was canonized in 1391. Her feast is July 23.
